JOB DESCRIPTION LABORER

<u>GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES</u>: A semi-skilled manual labor position involving all phases of public works activities.

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: This is semi-skilled labor work requiring moderate to strenuous physical effort with the individual having the ability and understanding to use and operate basic hand and power tools. Work is carried out in accordance with standard departmental practices, procedures and instructions which are given and checked by a supervisor. The work may require some disagreeable aspects, e.g., working in raw sewage, lifting weights up to 50 lbs. and responding to call outs for emergency situations in all types of weather conditions on a 24 hour basis including weekends and holidays.

<u>SPECIALIZATION</u>: At the entry level, this position requires a specialization in one or more of a number of specific fields (borough recognized trade) as designated by the borough that may be unique to a particular hire. Examples of such specialization may include one or more of the following: carpentry, electrical, landscaping, masonry, pesticides, plumbing, sewer root control, vermin control, or other skill designated in the job announcement.

EXAMPLES OF WORK: (Illustrative Only)

Operates all hand and power tools Operates air compressor, walk behind roller, ditch tamper and gasoline powered earth drilling machine. Building maintenance Perform other tasks as required

RELATED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS & ABILITIES

Knowledge of the use of basic hand and power tools and their safe use.

Knowledge of safe basic work practices.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

Ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions.

Ability to establish and maintain good working relationships with co-workers and the general public.

Ability to operate a standard transmission vehicle.

Introductory level skill in a borough recognized trade (e.g., carpentry, electrical, mechanical, welding, masonry, etc. if required by borough officials)

Must be in good physical condition to perform strenuous manual labor.

ACCEPTABLE EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING: Completion of High School or equivalent and Trade School or any equivalent combination of experience and training which provides the required knowledge, skills and abilities.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS: Must have Pennsylvania motor vehicle operator's license. Must accept the responsibility to work on a 24 hour call out basis for emergency situations in all types of weather conditions. Must acquire a Pennsylvania Class A Commercial Driver's License not later than twelve (12) months after employment start date as agreed to in the contract governing this position. In addition to the CDL Class A, special endorsements and restrictions may be required to drive certain types of commercial vehicles. May be required to attend classes and seminars associated with the position at the direction of the Borough Manager. Employment offered contingent upon completion of successful background check, physical and drug test.
